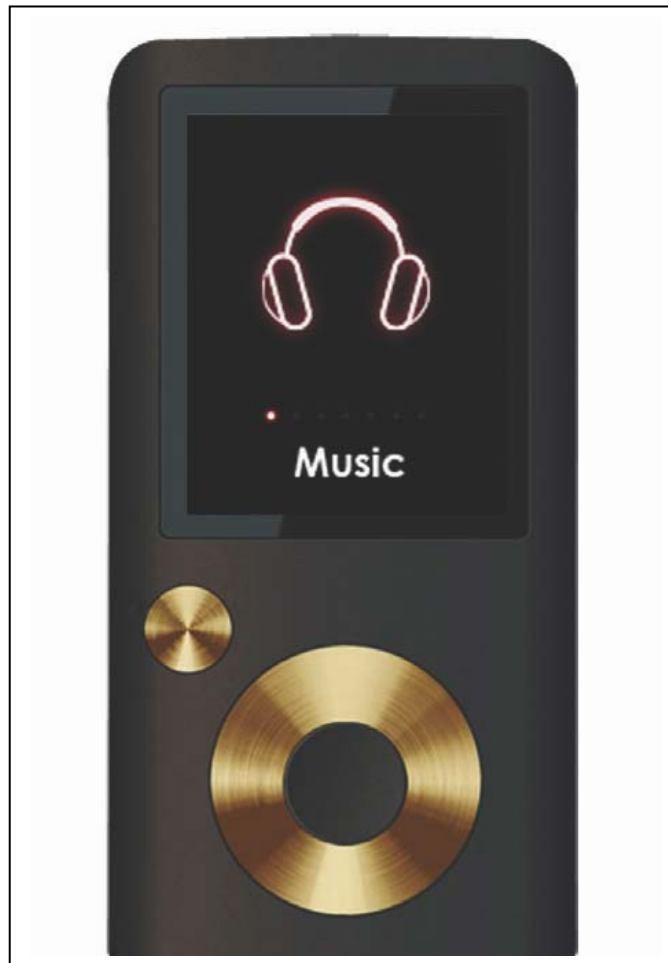

# Thank you for choosing a COBY MP3 player!

This guide will cover how to get started playing music with your COBY player. For more information about your player and its features, please consult the Instruction Manual or visit us on the web at [www.cobyusa.com](http://www.cobyusa.com).

## Requirements

Make sure you have the following items ready to start playing music on your COBY MP3 player.

### **Coby MP3 Player, Headphones, and USB Cable**

- ✦ If your COBY uses a rechargeable battery, make sure that it has been fully charged.
- ✦ Connect the headphones to the headphone jack on your COBY.

### **Computer with USB support**

- ✦ Most modern computers come equipped with a USB port. Please check with the computer manufacturer if you are not sure that your computer has USB support.

### **Windows Media Player 11 (WMP11)**

- ✦ The directions in this guide are given for WMP11, but you may use any media management software on your computer.

# Getting Started with **MUSIC** Transfer

To start playing music, you will need to:

- ✦ Music files on your computer
- ✦ Transfer the music files to your COBY player
- ✦ Start music playback on your COBY player




## Windows Media Player 11 (WMP11)

If your computer does not have Windows Media Player installed, please download the latest version of Windows Media Player (WMP) from Microsoft's website.

The current version available is Windows Media Player 11.

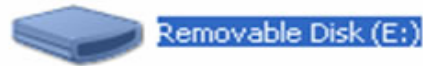
After you have followed Microsoft's instructions to install WMP on your computer, you will be ready to put music files on your computer.

 *For more information about how to use the features of WMP, press the F1 key on your keyboard while the program is running.*

# Put MP3 Music Files on Your Computer

If you **already** have MP3 or WMA music files on your computer, transfer them by:

- a) Locate your music files.
- b) Locate the MP3 Player under “MY Computer”. The MP3 player will be listed as a

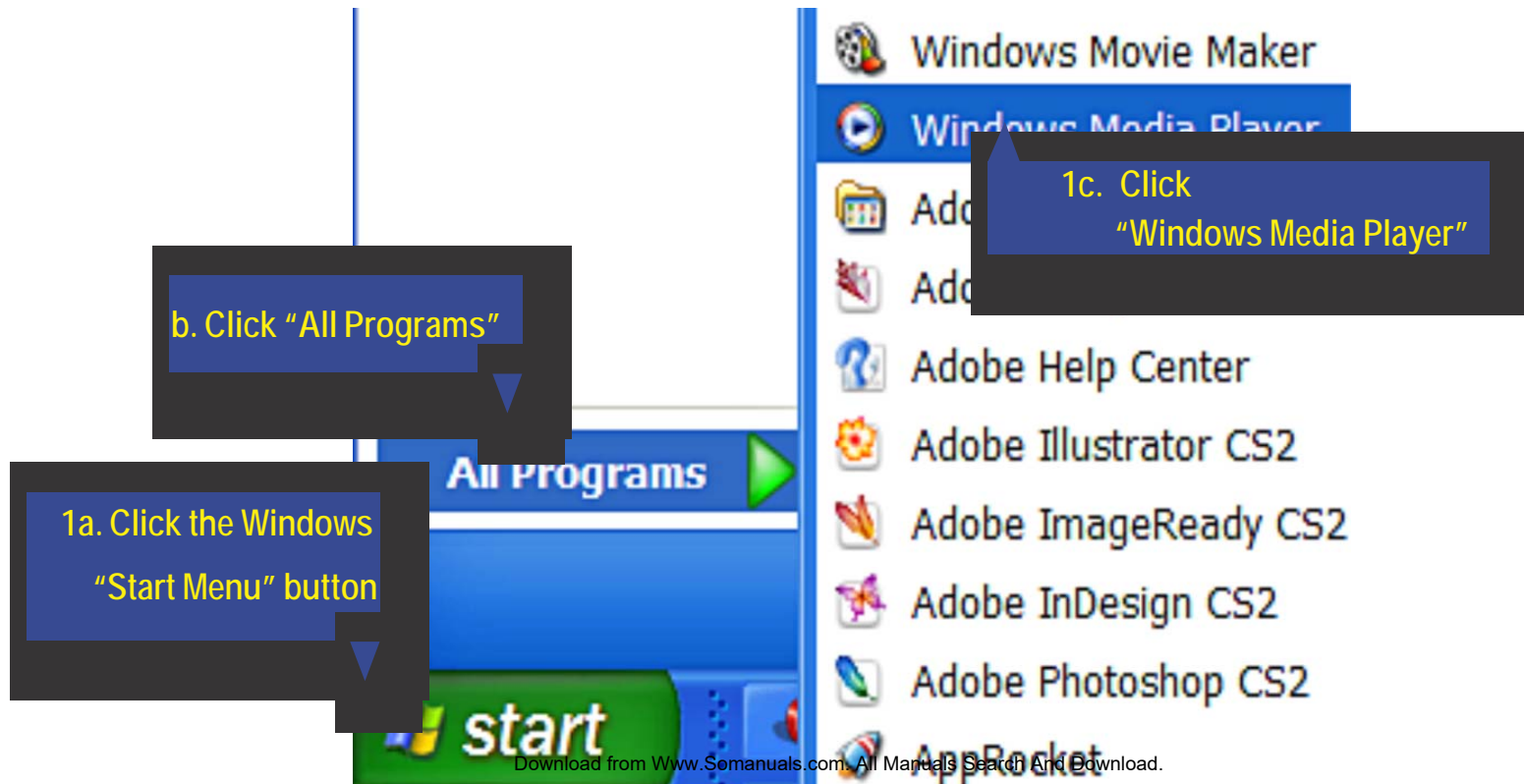


“Removable Disk”

- d) Transfer your existing music files (Copy and Paste or Drag and Drop) in the “Removable Disk”.

If you do not have music files:

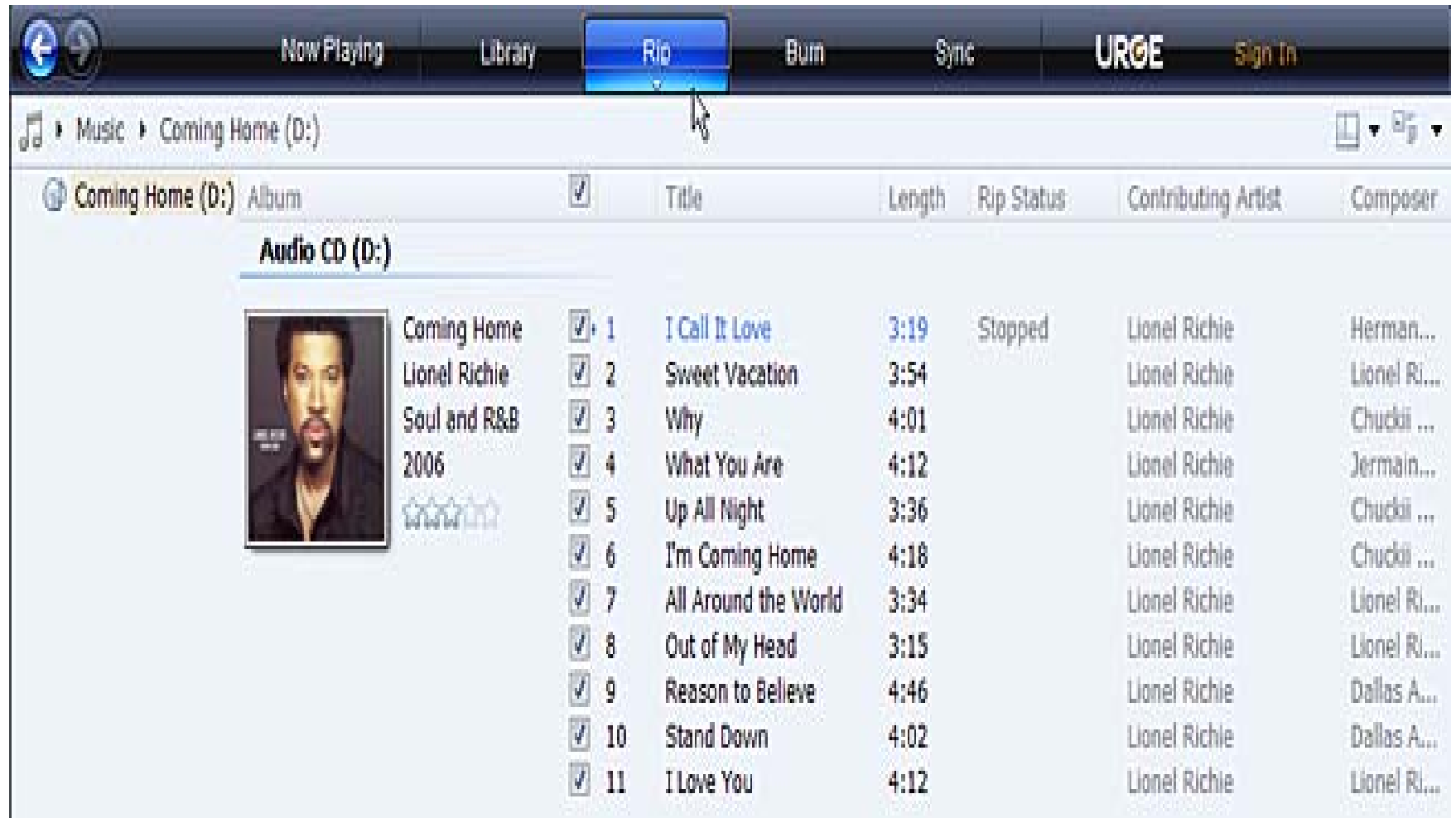
## 1) Launch the WMP11 program.



## 2) Put an audio CD into the CD-ROM drive of your computer.

If your computer has an internet connection, WMP will automatically retrieve and display the album information.

- ✦ Click the checkboxes to select which tracks to rip. To rip the entire album, check all of the boxes.



### 3) Set the Rip Options (optional).

- ✦ Click the “Rip” button to set the Rip options. The recommended Rip settings are:
  - ✧ Select “Format > mp3”
  - ✧ Select “Bit Rate > 128 Kbps”
  - ✧ Select “More Options” to change the directory to which WMP saves your ripped music files. WMP will save your music to your “My Documents > My Music” folder by default.



## 4) Start ripping the CD.

- ✦ Click the “Rip” button and select “Rip” to start converting the audio CD to MP3/WMA digital music files.



- ✦ The ripping process will take a few minutes to complete. WMP will save the converted music files to your “My Documents > My Music” folder by default.



## Transfer MP3/WMA Files to Your COBY Player

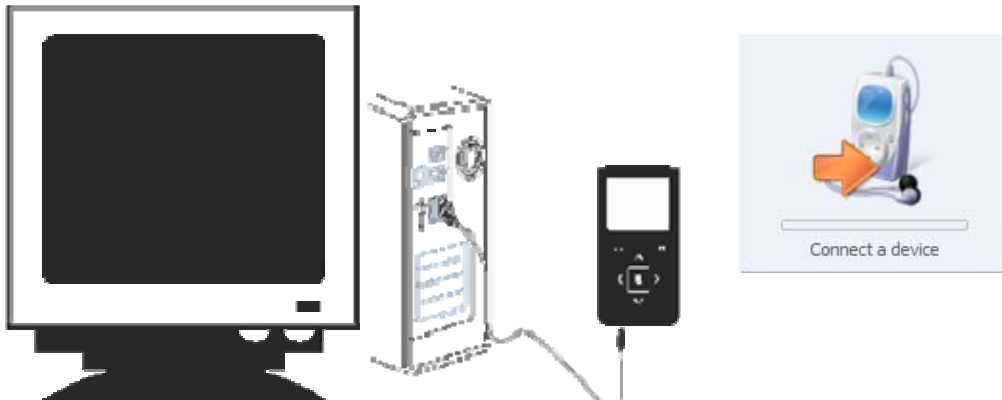
Once you have MP3 or WMA digital music files on your computer, transfer them to your COBY player in order to listen to music anywhere.

Use WMP11 to transfer (sync) music from your computer to your COBY MP3 player.

**1) Launch the WMP11 program.**

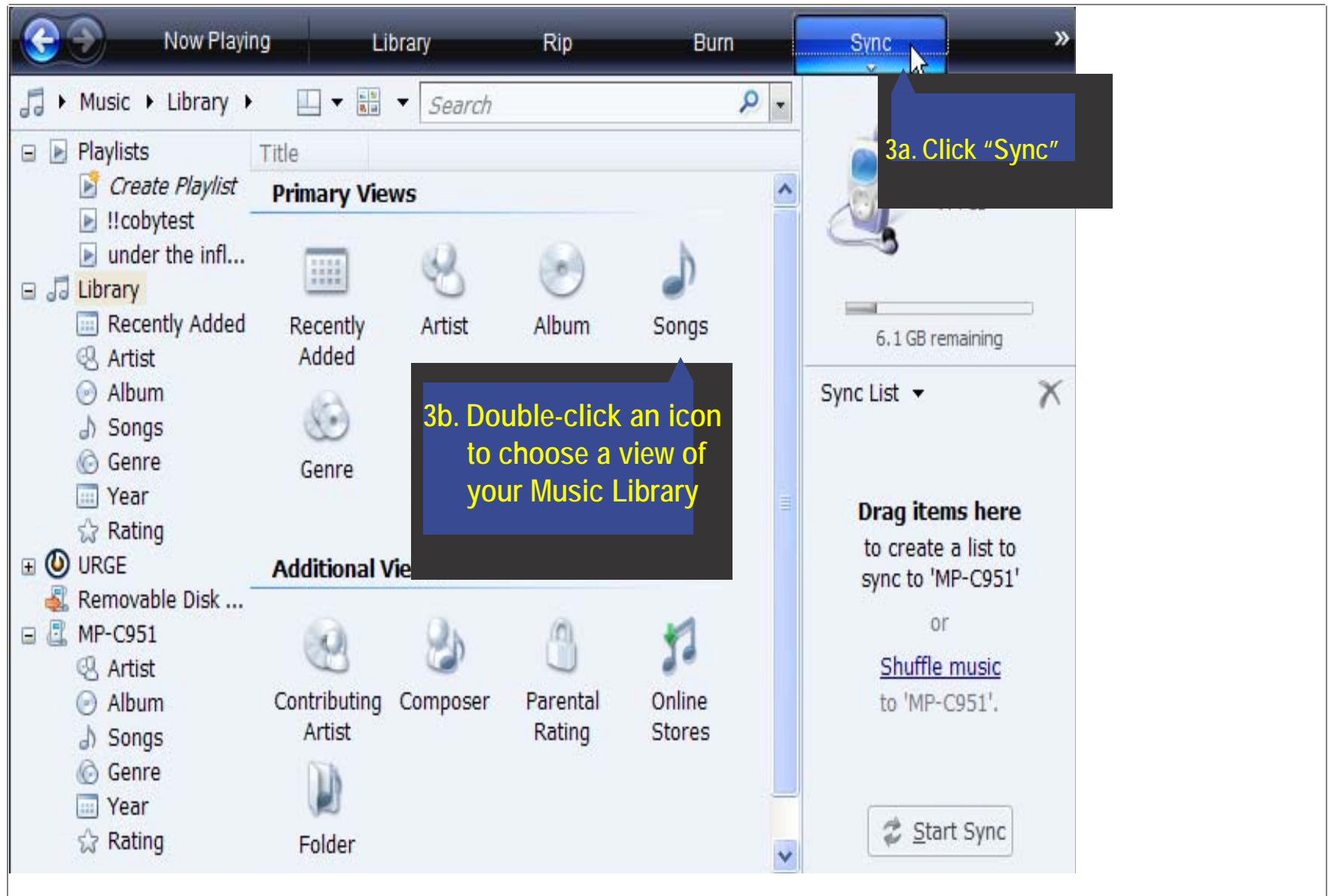
**2) Connect your COBY player to a USB port on the computer.**

✦ WMP11 will detect your COBY player automatically.






### 3) Browse your music library to choose songs to sync.



## 4) Select songs to sync to your COBY player.

**4a.** Type in the Search bar to quickly find a Song

**4b.** Click on a track to select it for synchronization. To select multiple tracks, hold CTRL or SHIFT and click on the track.

**4c.** Drag the selected tracks here to add them to the Sync List

**4d.** Click "Start Sync" to transfer the Sync List to your COBY player

## 5) Disconnect your COBY player from the computer.

Once the sync process is complete, unplug your player from the USB port of the computer. Now you're ready to listen to music on your COBY player.

## Start Listening to Music on Your COBY Player

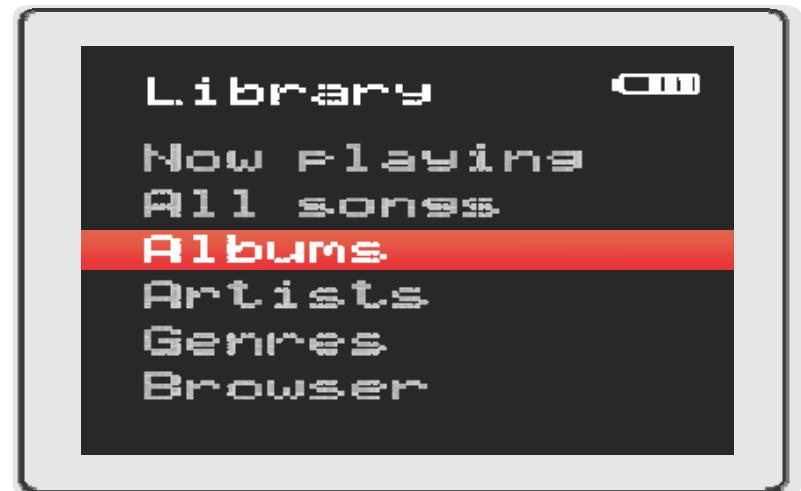
Now that you have transferred music to your COBY player, you're ready to take your music with you anywhere.

- ✦ Disconnect the MP3 player from the computer. Connect the supplied earphones to the headphone jack.
- ✦ Turn on your COBY player (Slide the Power Button to the "ON" position).

### Music browser Controls

When you choose MUSIC mode from the Main menu, you will see the Music Browser screen.

You can choose to browse your music by song name, album, artist, or genre.

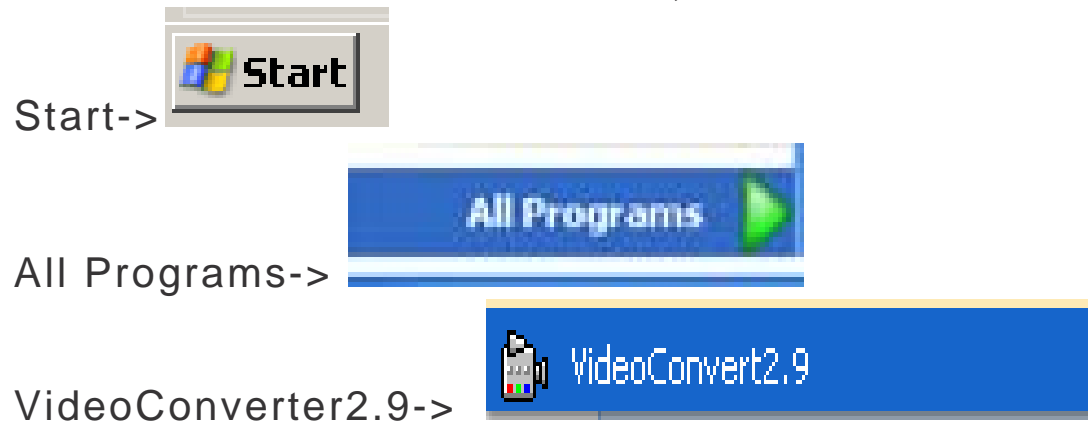
# Getting Started with **VIDEO** Transfer

## Install the conversion software (MTV Converter)

1. The MP3 player contain a folder called “ Video Converter”. Copy the Video Converter folder to your desktop.
2. Once the Video Converter folder is on your desktop, go into the folder and Double-click on the “**Setup.exe**” file to start the installation process.
3. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation process.

## Converting Video

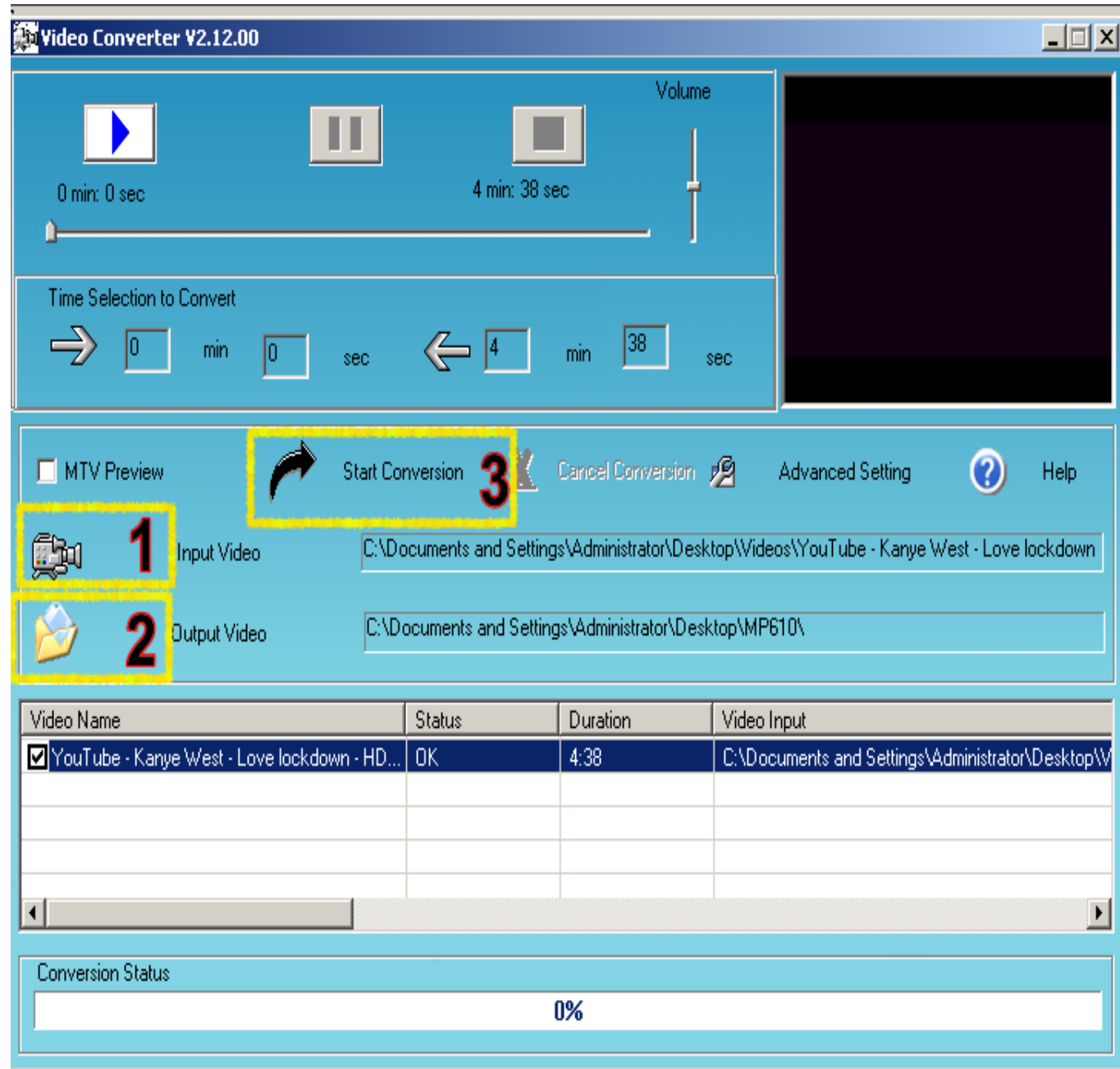
To start the conversion software, Go to:



**The application window shown below will appear.**

The Conversion software screen will appear. Use this screen to add video conversion jobs to the queue.

1. Click on the camera icon to locate the files needed to be converted. The source file must be one of the following video types: AVI, WMV, ASF, MPG, MOV, VOB, RM, and .3GP.
2. Click on the Folder icon to select an Output location where the converted video will be saved.
3. Click the “Start Conversion” to start the conversion process.



## Transfer the converted VIDEO files to Your COBY Player

1. Connect the player to your computer with the supplied USB 2.0 cable.
2. Double-click on the “MY COMPUTER” icon on your desktop.



3. The player will be listed as “Removable Disk”.
4. Go to the “Output location” where the converted Video files were saved. Copy and Paste or Drag and Drop the converted files in the “Removable



Disk, MOVIE.DIR folder”.

## Start watching Video files on your COBY Player

Now that you have transferred Video files to your COBY player, you're ready to take your music with you anywhere.

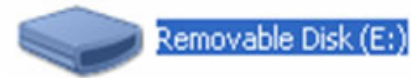
- ✦ Disconnect the MP3 player from the computer. Connect the supplied earphones to the headphone jack.
- ✦ Turn on your COBY player (Slide the Power Button to the “ON” position).
- ✦ Start the playback on your COBY player by entering the “MOVIES” menu, select the file and press Play.

# Transfer **PHOTO** files to Your COBY Player

1. Connect the player to your computer with the supplied USB 2.0 cable.
2. Double-click on the “MY COMPUTER” icon on your desktop.



3. The player will be listed as “Removable Disk”.
4. Locate your JPEG image files.  
Copy and Paste or Drag and Drop your JPEG files in the “Removable

Disk”, PHOTO.DIR folder  PHOTO.DIR . . . . . Done!!!

## Start viewing photo files on Your COBY Player

Now that you have transferred photo files to your COBY player, you’re ready to view the files.

- ✦ Disconnect the MP3 player from the computer. Turn on your COBY player (Slide the Power Button to the “ON” position).
- ✦ Start viewing your photo files on your COBY player by entering the “Pictures” menu, select the file and press Play.
